Step 1: Wake Up - Take Inventory of Your Circle

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2 Are they pushing you closer to your purpose, or pulling you away from it? Be honest.
Reflect on Proverbs 13:20: "Walk with the wise and become wise, for a companion of fools suffers harm."  How has your circle influenced your choices and growth?

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### Mark 2:5 says:
